OUR OBJECTIVES

How we will do this?

1. Recognise the strategic plan for the harbour and catchments from Ngāti Toa Rangatira
2. Advocate for the restoration of the health of the harbour and its contributing waters to the various statutory and other organisations including: GWRC, PCC, DoC, MPI, Waka Kotahi, Kiwi Rail, Gas and Electricity line providers
3. Monitor the performance and publicly hold accountable the actions of the management agencies relating to the harbour and its catchments
4. Foster community awareness of the history and current state of the harbour and catchments and what might be achieved in future
5. Acknowledge conflicts and agree to make progress rather than no progress on the desired end state of the harbour and its waters.
6. Promote development of a long term strategy and action plans.
7. Promote and support implementation of Te Awarua o Porirua Whaitua Implementation Plan.
8. Engage and work with like-minded community organisations and individuals to achieve our objectives.
