Would you like to be part of shaping the future for our mokopuna in Porirua?

Ngāti Toa Rangatira and the wider Porirua Community are working on an exciting new community project, the **Porirua Assembly on Climate** (the Assembly) in which a group of everyday people will take part in discussions to address the guestion:

Learning to live with Porirua's changing world together:

How do we connect and respond as our climate changes?

The Porirua Assembly is harnessing the power of our community to drive local change. It's an opportunity for everyday people from all walks of life to be part of shaping the future for our mokopuna here in our city/home.

This is an invitation to register your interest in being selected for the Assembly.

Approximately 50 everyday people from age 15 will be selected via a fair and transparent process that will ensure the participants reflect the Porirua community. Rangatahi and Tamariki will have ways to participate, through schools, in a Rangatahi wānanga taking place before the Assembly, and at the Assembly itself.

No prior knowledge is needed to join the assembly. Participants will hear from experts, learn, discuss and prepare recommendations that will be handed directly to local and regional decision makers and Porirua's own Community Leaders' Forum.

The Assembly will meet over 4 sessions – the 15th and 22nd of February, and the 15th and 29th of March 2025.

These are in-person meetings to be held at Pataka. We can provide some financial assistance with travel or care responsibilities if needed. To be eligible for selection as a Participant, you must be able to come to all of these meeting times.
